## Court refuses council appea

Days before a TV exposé about leaseholder over-charging featuring Islington Council, a group of residents hope their battle is at an end after the town hall was refused permission to appeal a ruling that it blew £1million on housing improvements.

Monday's edition of investigative Channel Four show Dispatches features the Tremlett Grove Estate, in Archway, which was the subject of a Leasholder Valuation Tribunal (LVT) in April. It found the council paid over the odds for work on two blocks.

The ruling meant the coun-

cil will have to refund aroun £16,000 to each of the 14 lease holders affected.

The LVT refused the cour cil the right to appeal but i took the matter to the Land Tribunal, a higher body which also refused the righ of appeal on August 2.

The council is howeve considering taking the cas to the Administrative Coura division of the High Cours on a point of law.

A spokesman for the cour cil said: "The tribunal is no saying that this work wa unnecessary, but rather the wanted more evidence t prove it was necessary."
